Since 1353 the Counts Serego Alighieri have taken care of the winemaking aspect of their own properties. The light aging in cherry barrels gives unmistakable personality to this red wine of body, fruity and spicy. An elegant wine for multiple matching with food.

GRAPE VARIETIES

Corvina, Rondinella, Molinara (Serego Alighieri clone).

TASTING NOTES

Look: lively, ruby red.

Nose: typical cherry aromas, with delicate spicy notes, particularly cinnamon.

Palate: well-structured with good acidity and intense aromas of ripe cherries. Long finish with hints of resinated wood.

EXPERIENCE

'Possessioni' is the ideal glass to accompany traditional local dishes, from fresh pasta to risottos, as well as tasty vegetarian recipes, meat and fish paellas, roast beef or speck with potatoes, cheeses of medium ripening.
